2. **Grass Playing Fields** -- Grass fields will be open to use on Saturday, however the Park Staff will still be working on field maintenance over the next 2 weeks, including but not limited to some grading some fields and the painting of field lines. Some fields are still wet in areas, youth associations will be notified of these conditions.
3. **Artist Request for Proposals - Bottineau Cultivate** – seeking RFPs for art projects to be completed this year. **Cultivate Bottineau: Culture, Community and Commerce** is a collaborative effort to activate spaces, build connections, celebrate diversity, and promote opportunity through local artist-led creative placemaking projects in the Bottineau Corridor where the planned Bottineau Light Rail Transit line will run. 4. **Prescription Drug Take-Back Day** –Saturday, April 27th 10 am – 2 pm at Robbinsdale Hy-Vee, 3505 Bottineau Blvd, Robbinsdale, MN 55422. The Hennepin County Sheriff’s Office, in partnership with Robbinsdale Hy-Vee, Partnership for Change, North Memorial Health and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration will give the public its 17th opportunity in nine years to prevent pill abuse and theft by ridding their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. Sites cannot accept liquids or needles or sharps, only pills or patches. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.

7. **Spring Load Limits In Effect** -- With the warm weather, comes spring load limits. During this time, heavier loads are not permitted on local streets. Refer to the Spring Load Limit Map on the city webpage for details on weight limits for various streets (type “spring load limits” in the search field).



8. **Note from Robbinsdale Code Enforcement Department** – The city spends a lot of time with home owners and tenants in regards to long grass and vegetation violations. Robbinsdale city ordinance 820.15 subd 1. If grass/vegetation is not taken care of and the property receives notice (which can be posted to the properties door), the grass must be cut within 7 days of the date on the compliance order. Failure to correct the violation, or to make arrangements satisfactory to the city to achieve compliance with this ordinance, will result in the city or its contractor entering the property and abating the nuisance at your cost. This fee will be added to the properties utility bill and an invoice will be sent to the property owner for the services rendered.
